Health & Safety Policy - 1

The Purpose of this policy is to ensure that:

All staff and members of The Imps Motorcycle Display Team are aware that they are required to ensure that all activities are carried out in a way that fully complies with this policy.

The Team Director has ultimate responsibility to ensure that this policy is regularly updated and that the staff and membership are adequately protected from risk. He is also required to ensure that relevant qualifications, eg, First Aid, CRB Clearances and Child Safety Certificates are in place and in date.

The Assistant Team Director is appointed as Health and Safety Officer. The duties of the H&S Officer are to ensure that risk assessments exist for all activities, and that they are reviewed annually. He is also required to ensure that a Site Specific Risk Assessment is completed and signed on all occasions before training or display riding commences.

Intended Results are to:

- Provide and maintain a healthy, safe operating environment at all times
- Ensure adequate control of health and safety risks arising from our activities, this includes communication with parents, members and any use of sub-contractors
- Provide all required instruction, training, supervision and other relevant health and safety information to our members and voluntary staff
- Ensure that all staff and young people are competent in the activities they are engaged in
- Continue to consult with and update staff & members on all Health and Safety issues



Health & Safety Policy - 2

- Provide, as a minimum, 'generic' risk assessments for all common tasks engaged in by staff & members where risk is involved and potential danger has been identified
- Encourage all personnel to take reasonable care for the health and safety of him/herself, fellow members and all persons accordingly and to report any hazard, which cannot be controlled personally, to appropriate personnel.
